

# **Agro-foresty or Permaculture Volunteer**

BGET is developing the Grace Garden Sustainable for the various appropriate technologies that are suitable for life along the Thailand-Burma border. One of the focus areas of this site will be renewable energy technology currently utilized by BGET including solar electric, solar hot water, biogas, and solar cooking. Additional focus is placed on sustainable building and agriculture. The agro-forestry volunteer will work with BGET staff to establish a functioning food forest with emphasis on techniques applicable to migrant schools, refugee camps, and Thai/Karen villages. This volunteer may be asked to live part time or full time at the learning center.

#### **Responsibilities:**

- Assist with the development of a food forest to promote food crops, reforestation techniques, and marketable forest products.
- Research and experiment with multiple use plants suitable for this tropical environment.
- Additional duties may include: establishing a tree nursery, working in the vegetable garden, participating in earthen building, assisting with a wide variety of appropriate technology installations, and leading small groups of short-term volunteers.

## **Desired qualifications:**

- Educational/Work background with an emphasis in agriculture, forestry, horticulture, or permaculture.
- Hands-on experience working on farms or living in sustainable communities.
- Previous experience traveling or living in developing countries.
- Basic understanding of renewable energy systems and appropriate technologies is helpful but not required.
